Playwriting Workshop

As part of the 3rd Annual GPT 10-minute Play Festival, the **two-session, Saturday morning workshop** is scheduled for November 8 and November 22 at 9:30 at 315 Fisher Road. There is no charge for this workshop. If you have a laptop, bring it along because we'll do some writing at least in the first session!

We're dealing with writing the short, ten-minute plays (six to eight typewritten pages). The focus this year will be on Getting Started: Picking the characters, deciding who's going to do what, developing the plot and getting the first several lines of dialog onto the paper. Between sessions, participants will write their play(s) and we'll read them back and forth during the second session.

You don't have to attend the workshop to submit plays for the Festival. **Anyone can submit a ten-minute play for consideration. The deadline is January 1, 2015**, and the winning plays will be performed for the membership at our April 13 Membership Meeting.
